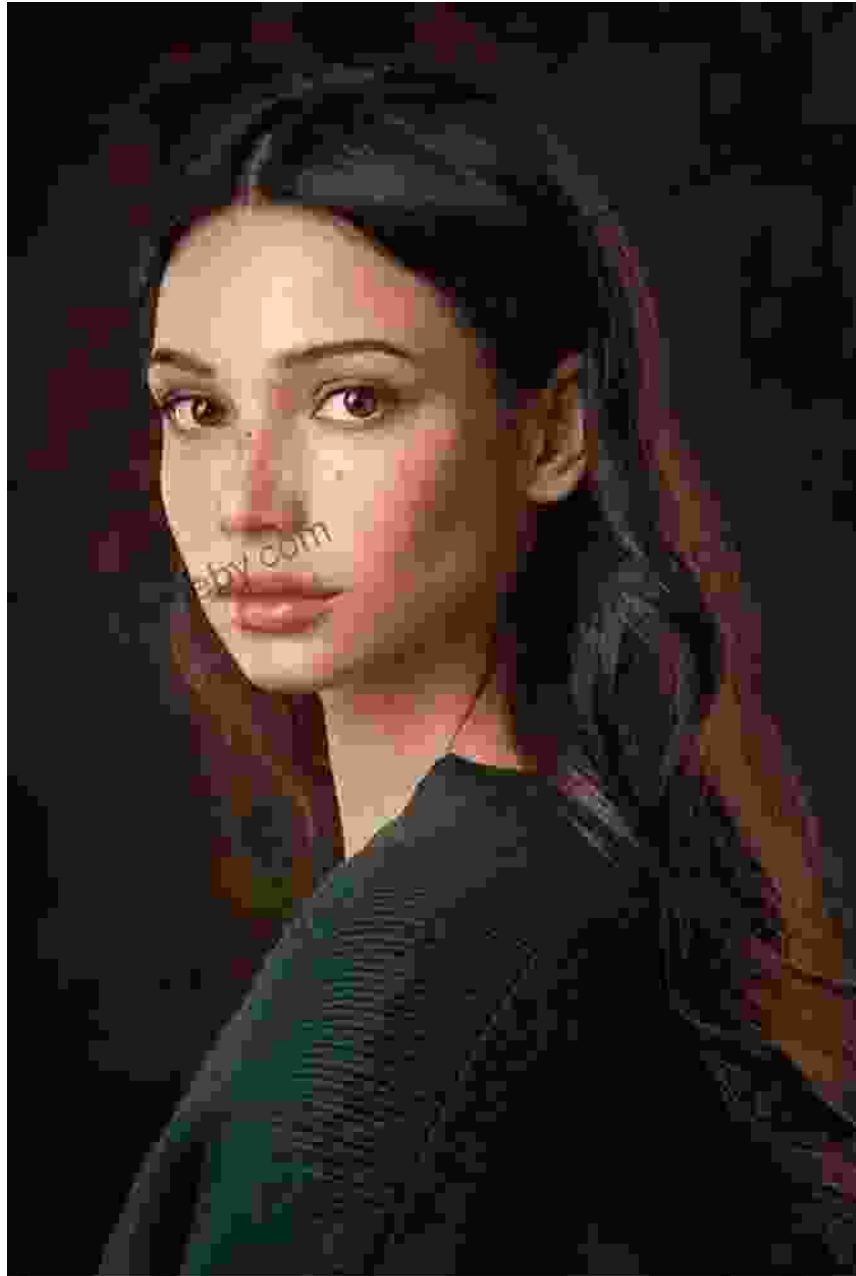


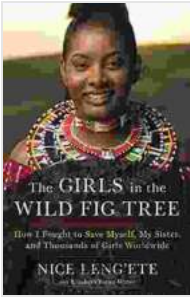

- Report any suspicious activity to the authorities

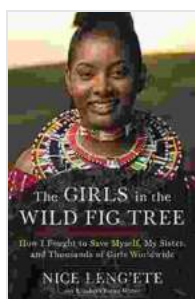
What You Can Do to Help Survivors
